Dr. Lynette Cornelius is the Clerk of Court for the El Paso County Combined Courts. She has earned an Associates of Applied Science degree in Paralegal Studies, a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice Administration, a Master's degree in Business Administration, and a Doctorate degree in Organization Leadership. She is a graduate of the Judicial Branch's Leadership Development Institute and the Judicial Executive Development Institute (JEDI). Dr. Cornelius began her career with the Judicial Branch in 1996, as a file clerk in the Records Management Department of the El Paso County Combined Courts. In November of 2001, Dr. Cornelius transferred her position to the 18th Judicial District as a CJA for the Arapahoe District Court, in Centennial, Colorado. In 2005, while working for the Arapahoe District Court, she was promoted to the position of Supervisor in the Clerk's Office. In 2006, she was transferred to the Arapahoe County Court in Aurora, Colorado, where she supervised the County Court Clerk's Office for four years. In November of 2010, she returned to the El Paso County Combined Courts in Colorado Springs, Colorado, as the Clerk of Court. This year marks Dr. Cornelius' 19th year working for the Judicial Branch.
